

How shall we talk this day?

Worthily

Philippians 1

²⁷ Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;
Becometh – axios (ax-ee'-oce); adverb from NT:514; appropriately:
KJV - as becometh, after a godly sort, worthily (-thy).

Not as we used to talk

Ephesians 2

³ Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

Galatians 1

¹³ For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

Hebrews 13

⁵ Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Put away our former way of speaking

Ephesians 4

²¹ If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:
²² That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
²³ And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

Talk recognizing we are an example of the Saint

1 Timothy 4

¹² Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.

Our conversation should be holy

1 Peter 1

¹⁵ But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

With knowledge and study of Word we speak by the holy Spirit

Luke 12

¹² For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

Speak as God is speaking through you...

1 Peter 4

¹¹ If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Oracles – logion (log'-ee-on); neuter of NT:3052; an utterance (of God):
KJV - oracle.
